

THE GOLD COAST BRIDGE CLUB

A Brief History

The inaugural meeting of the GCBC was held at the old Southport Hotel on 20 October 1964 with 51 founding members. The club operated from the Surfers Paradise Bowls Club. When these premises became too expensive, the club moved to playing at the Methodist Hall in Clifford Street. Funds were raised to allow the purchase of the club's own freehold in 1972, followed by construction of a clubhouse which opened in 1973.

From the outset, and continuing to present times, the club has made extensive renovations and seen many changes, including:

- 1982 Verandah enclosed, creating extra playing space
- 1983 Computers were introduced and results available the same day
- 1998 Smoking prohibited in the club
- 1992 Automatic dealing machine installed, the first by an Australian bridge club
- 1996 Communication tower constructed on GCBC land, providing an annual income
- 2008 Bidding boxes introduced
- 2010 Bridgemates and the Compscore scoring program
- 2012 The club obtained informal access to parking on adjoining Telstra land
- Ongoing improvements to the club have included refurbishing the clubhouse, installing a ramp, solar panels and electronic gates.

Due to the dedication and hard work of numerous people over the years, GCBC members now enjoy a high standard of bridge, excellent teaching, and participation in many social activities.

BY-LAWS OF THE GOLD COAST BRIDGE CLUB

A GENERAL

- 1. These by-laws apply to all persons on the club's premises, whether or not club members and/or players.
- Bridge properties in conduct and play, as set out in "Laws of Contract Bridge", must be observed at all times.
- Mobile phones must be turned off during play (see QBA Regulations on Electronic Communication Devices).
- Each pair must have at least one adequately completed ABF system card on the table during play (one such system card for each player during all competitions).
- 5. In restricted sections (or the lowest section of graded events), green and blue systems are allowed. In other sections/events, green, blue and red systems, and brown sticker conventions are allowed, with yellow systems allowed only if approved by both the director and any opponents against whom the yellow system is proposed to be used.
- 6. At least 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time each player physically present (and only those players) must fill out (or cause to be filled out on their behalf), and place on the table at which they intend to play in the first round, an attendance slip noting their presence. The club may grant a physically disabled person the facility to reserve a table and/or have an attendance slip filled out on their behalf without that player being present. The club may withdraw such facility at any time without reason.
- Slow play is subject to penalisation (see QBA Regulations).
 A timing clock is usually set after the 1st round. Bidding on a new board must not be started after the warning bell has gone.
- The defender on opening lead and dummy must not delay making the opening lead, or putting their hand down (as appropriate), to enter the contract on their personal scorer or in the Bridgemate.

- Each player is responsible for entering their club number in the Bridgemate. North/South pair is responsible for entering the score and East/West for checking. North/South is responsible for placing and moving boards. East/West is responsible for removing cups, paper, etc and putting chairs, side-tables and bidding boxes in their proper place at the season's end.
- 10. The club has and implements a policy on player behaviour (see separate document "Best Behaviour at Bridge".)
- 11. Bidding boxes are in use at the club, and ABF rules pertaining to them must be observed.
- 12. Dress code smart casual. No singlets or rubber thongs.
- 13. The Tournament Committee may designate some sessions as "Handicap Sessions". Handicaps are determined by the scoring system. Overall winners retain masterpoints. Nett winners receive any prize ticket issued.
- 14. The club has the right to use photos/video taken in the playing area to publicise the club and/or bridge generally.
- 15. Subscriptions run from 1 September to 30 August, and are due on 1 September each year.

B. DIRECTORS

- 16. The director must be called for any infraction of the laws, including rudeness or other inappropriate behaviour.
- 17. The ruling of the director must be accepted at the table. However an appeal may be lodged through the director within 30 minutes of the end of the session.
- 18. Scoring errors, if noticed, should be reported to the director during play. The right to appeal a scoring error, or an adjustment made by the director to an apparent scoring error, expires (except when a title or prize money is awarded promptly after the session ends), 48 hours after the official score has been published on the internet or otherwise made available for inspection.
- 19. The director has the right to refuse entry to any person into the Club Rooms.

C. COMPETITIONS

- 20. If an event has an entry/nomination form on the club's competition notice board, a player must submit the entry form or nominate on the nomination form (before the announced cut-off date, if any) to ensure a place in such event. A player so entering/nominating, but failing to attend, may be required to show cause why they should not be disciplined.
- 21. Player substitution policy is as per QBA Regulations, except (a) substitutes are permitted for convenience, and need not be sought in advance of the event; (b) the substitute should, in the director's opinion, be of a similar standard to the replaced player; (c) the power of the director to waive, in an emergency, substitution requirements is not limited to congress events; (d) in a two session pairs event, if a player plays for only one session, no member of the pair for either week is eligible for the event's title, trophy, or prize money, or the overall event masterpoints.
- 22. Entry to Club Championship events is open to non-members, but any title, prize money or trophy in such event will be awarded to the pair or team of the highest placed club members.
- 23. The club will normally appoint a director who is not playing in the event for the following events: Club Pairs Championship, Club Teams Championship, Gold Coast Bridge Club Cup, President's Cup and the Club's Masters Pairs.
- 24. Breaking of Ties QBA policy applies.
- 25. An extra fee will apply for all red masterpoint events. If insufficient players are present for a non-red masterpoint side event/section, and players are absorbed into the Red Point competition, they are to pay the Red masterpoint fee.
- 26. In the Club Masters Pairs event, ranking is determined by the number of masterpoints a player has at the end of the quarter before the event.

- 27. If an event is being seeded, in determining the seeding, the director may take into account factors such as masterpoints and their assessment of the current standard of the relevant player/s.
- 28. If any prize money is not claimed within 3 months of the completion of a competition it may be forfeited to the club.

Eclectic Events

There will be eclectic points awarded for play across all sections of the Club

Eclectics are an easy way for players to earn a large number of masterpoints. The greater number of green points generated ensures that more red point sessions will be allocated to the Club.

On designated eclectic days walk-in players automatically participate without prior registration. A participant may choose a different partner for each eclectic session, but competes in the whole eclectic as an individual.

To qualify for competitive placings and masterpoints in an eclectic, a player must have participated in at least the minimum number of sessions prescribed for that eclectic. An eclectic is usually confined to within a single month.

If he or she plays in more than the minimum number of relevant sessions for that particular event, only their best session percentages count towards the eclectic result. Participation in another concurrent competition similarly does not qualify.
